

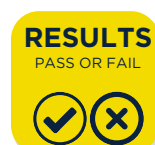
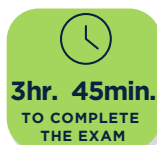
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- RN License: current, unrestricted RN license in state or country of practice
- Academic Degree: pre-licensure degree (diploma in nursing, associate degree in nursing [ADN], or the global equivalent) or higher
- Experience: Current full- or part-time employment in an ambulatory surgery setting and a minimum of 2 years and 2,400 hours of experience in an eligible role with a minimum of 500 hours in the intraoperative setting.
 - Employment setting may be hospital-based, free-standing, or physician-owned.
 - The role may be clinical, administrative, educational, or research.
 - Experience in a non-paid volunteer capacity is acceptable.

If you are a CFPN® credential holder or have earned your CST, TS-C, or military equivalent, a minimum of 18 months and 2,400 hours of experience as a perioperative registered nurse is required.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Hold an active CNAMB credential, and current, unrestricted RN license.
- Currently working full- or part-time in an ambulatory surgery setting with a minimum of 500 hours of experience per year in an eligible role in the perioperative setting. This is a total of 1500 hours during your 3-year accrual cycle. Once you hold the CNAMB[®] credential there is no requirement for hours worked in intraoperative care.
- Employment setting may be hospital-based, free-standing, or physician-owned.
- The role may be clinical, administrative, educational, or research.
- Experience in a non-paid volunteer capacity is acceptable.

RECERTIFICATION OPTIONS

Professional Activity Points | \$289

Requirement: 200 points

Engage in eligible professional activities during your accrual period to earn points toward your recertification. Earn 200 points in any of the categories to meet the requirement.

CNAMB Extension Year | \$257

Active CNAMBs unable to complete professional activities during the accrual period may apply for a one-year extension allow an additional year to complete activities.

CNAMB Emeritus | \$184

Retiring or ineligible perioperative nurses may preserve their CNAMB credential with a one-time fee for Emeritus Status. Emeritus Status entitles the nurse to use the designation CNAMB(E).
