

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A current, unrestricted RN license in the country where currently practicing.
- · Currently working full- or part-time or completing volunteer work in perioperative nursing clinical practice, nursing education, administration, or research.
- Have worked or volunteered a minimum of 2 years and 2,400 hours in perioperative nursing, with a minimum of 1,200 hours in the intraoperative setting.*

*CFPN® credential-holders or nurses that hold/have previously held the CST or TS-C (NCCT) credential and have graduated from either a U.S. military training course or a CAAHEP accredited training course must have a minimum of 18 months and 2,400 hours of experience in perioperative nursing, with a minimum of 1,200 hours in the intraoperative setting.

RECERTIFICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Hold an active CNOR credential, and current, unrestricted RN license.
- Currently working full- or part-time in perioperative nursing clinical practice, nursing education, administration, or research.
- Have worked or volunteered a minimum of 500 hours in perioperative nursing within the 5-year recertification cycle. Of those 500 hours, 250 hours must be in the area of education, administration, research, or clinical practice that impacts intraoperative patient care.

RECERTIFICATION OPTIONS

1

Professional Activity Points | \$446 Requirement: 300 points Recertify before March 31 and pay **EARLY-BIRD DISCOUNT \$406**

Engage in eligible professional activities during your accrual period to earn points toward your recertification. Earn 300 points in any of the categories to meet the requirement.

2

Continuing Education Contact Hours* | \$446

Requirement: 125 contact hours

Earn 125 continuing education contact hours during your accrual period from CCI's pre-approved, accredited providers.

*Available to nurses who became CNOR-certified on or before 12/31/18 and last recertified prior to 2021.

3

CNOR Extension Year | \$255

Active CNORs unable to complete professional activities during the accrual period may apply for a one-year extension allow an additional year to complete activities.

4

CNOR Emeritus | \$184

Retiring or ineligible perioperative nurses may preserve their CNOR credential with a one-time fee for Emeritus Status. Emeritus Status entitles the nurse to use the designation CNOR(E).
